


Medical evacuation of Gaza patients

Oct 2023 - 10 Sep 2025


Pathway for patient evacuation for medical treatment outside of Gaza Strip




Timeline for patient medical evacuations

7672 Patients evacuated (7 Oct 2023 - 10 Sep 2025)
including 5332 children

7 May 24 - 18 Jan 25
Via Kerem Shalom due to Rafah crossing closure




18 Mar - 10 Sep 25 (Resumption of hostilities)



7 Oct 23 - 6 May 24 (Pre Rafah crossing closure)



19 Jan - 17 Mar 25 (Ceasefire period)



15 600 patients still need medical evacuation outside the Gaza Strip.

Top five medical needs evacuated since 7 May 2024

- 766** trauma
- 681** oncology
- 256** ophthalmology
- 241** Congenital anomalies
- 214** cardiovascular diseases



Top ten referral destinations since October 2023

- 3995** Egypt

- 970** Qatar
- 440** Turkey
- 299** EU countries
- 253** Jordan

WHO recommendations:

- Increase Member States' acceptance of patients from the Gaza Strip.
- Restore the medical corridor to the West Bank, including East Jerusalem.
- Increase corridors for medical evacuation through Egypt and Jordan.
- Ceasefire.



Before October 2023 between 50-100 patients were exiting the Gaza Strip daily for medical treatment.
